Safety and injury history

Rugby is a contact sport. Injuries are a part of any contact sport. However, serious or life-threatening injuries are rare in Rugby . To practice this sport as safely as possible, it is important that injuries and injury prevention are taken seriously. During rugby, instructions from the coach, trainer, first-aider and/or referee should always be followed.

World Rugby has established guidelines, outlining the prevention, recognition and proper treatment of injuries and concussions.

We advise every player and every parent of a player to read through these guidelines:

It is therefore very important, in case of an injury or medication use, to notify the coach/trainer beforehand. Furthermore, it is important to communicate in advance what sports you have experience with, for how long and at what level.

Conduct and house rules

- We adhere to the Rugby Values (<https://rugby.nl/rugby/beginnen-met-rugby/kernwaarden/>): Respect, discipline and camaraderie.
- We adhere to Rugby's code of conduct <https://rugby.nl/rugby/beginnen-met-rugby/gedragscode/>
- With us, everyone participates. Everyone treats each other with respect and kindness. Having fun is paramount.
- With us it is safe: discrimination, racism, intimidation, bullying, physical and mental violence are not allowed.
- We report problems to the coach or trainer and solve problems by talking about them.
- With us, everyone, including bystanders, listens to the coaches and trainers and we do this without contradicting the coach and trainer. If you do not agree, report it to the coach or trainer so that this disagreement can be resolved at an appropriate time and place.
- With us, we all work together to create a pleasant and safe sports environment and report it to the coach, trainer or confidential advisor if we do not feel safe and/or if we notice that someone else does not feel safe or is safe.
- With us, we all work towards a healthy sports environment: there is no smoking, no drinking of alcohol and no use of (soft) drugs, including bystanders.
- We behave as good guests and owners: we abide by the house rules of the (sports) complex where we train, play and/or are guests.
- In case of undesirable behaviour, Rugbyclub Alphen will take measures, which can lead to denial (without refund of membership fees) of training sessions, activities, meetings and competitions and possibly even to reporting to the competent authorities.

Consent Statement visual material

Rugby Club Alphen uses visual material (photographs and videos) for various purposes. Recordings are made during various occasions. For example, during training sessions. You may be recognisable on these images. This footage can, for example, be published on the website of Rugby Club Alphen. Naturally, this footage is always handled with care.

Why this permission statement

The General Data Protection Regulation or AVG requires us to ask permission for the use of visual material. In this way, Rugby Club Alphen wants to avoid misunderstandings about whether the visual material may be used. The requested permission applies to visual material created by Rugby Club Alphen itself or on behalf of Rugby Club Alphen.

What you give permission for
